1. English Speaking Course

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1. ENGLISH SPEAKING COURSE

1.1. COURSE DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE

This course is designed to help students develop and practice their English-speaking skills which they will need when working in a medical environment. The course focuses on listening, speaking, as well as grammar correction, vocabulary and pronunciation. Students will engage in tasks to help them learn and practice useful phrases for daily situations, and learn to speak English effectively and use it in both formal and informal settings. Each lesson will combine both independent and interactive learning tasks aimed at practicing language for a particular use.

1.2. COURSE DURATION

The course duration is over a 14-week period, one hour and thirty minutes/session.

1.3. GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

Using a balance of grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation and skills work, especially speaking, the course aims to extend students' ability to communicate confidently in English. By focusing on topics such as holidays, history, health, body, describing signs of illness, and conveying instructions to patients and colleagues, this course revises and builds upon the grammatical points taught to students earlier.

In this course, students will:

- Understand and use very basic expressions to satisfy concrete needs.
- Learn and practice useful English phrases and expressions.
- Introduce themselves and ask others questions about personal details.
- Understand frequently used expressions in most intermediate areas such as shopping, family, employment, health, illness, etc.
- Complete tasks that are routine and involve a direct exchange of information.
- Describe matters of immediate need in simple terms.
- Describe experiences, events, dreams, and ambitions, as well as opinions or plans in brief.
- Communication with people in the classroom and in real situations.

- Develop English speaking accuracy and fluency through interactive communicative tasks.

1.4. PLACE OF THE COURSE IN THE PROGRAM

The course takes place in the fall semester in the curriculum of the Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Nursing.

1.5. COURSE EVALUATION

Course evaluation consists of a midterm exam and a final exam grade. According to Ondokuz Mayıs University Regulations, a student who does not attend more than 30% of the theoretical courses cannot attend the final exam.

1.6. DISTANCE EDUCATION POLICY

The Nursing Department's Distance Education Policy is followed.
